The El Cerrito Recycling + Environmental Resource Center offers community members a convenient way to reduce their environmental footprint by offering comprehensive recycling and reuse services. As a LEED Platinum-certified facility that features a zero-net energy building, recycled rainwater catchment, rain gardens for treating storm water, native plantings, and reused building materials, the Center is a living model of sustainability.

MORE SERVICES

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Drop off HHW at the West County Resource Recovery facility at 101 Pittsburgh Ave, Richmond Wed - Sat. 9am-4pm. On **Tuesdays ONLY, 9am - 4pm**, HHW is accepted at the El Cerrito Recycling Center by HHW staff. RecycleMore service area residents only. Proof of residency is required. Call 1-888-412-9277 or visit RecycleMore.com for more information.

Bulk Loads: Transfer Stations

For drop-off of bulk loads of garbage, green waste, or construction debris. Fees apply.

- Richmond: **Golden Bear Transfer Station**, 1 Parr Blvd., Richmond, CA 94801, just west of the Richmond Parkway, open Mon-Fri 7am-5pm and Sat-Sun 9am-5pm, 510-970-7260.

- Berkeley: **Berkeley Transfer Station**, 1201 Second Street, Berkeley, CA 94710, just off the Gilman Street freeway exit, open Mon-Sat 8am-4:30pm, 510-981-7270.

Extra Pickups and Large Item Collection from EBS

Residents get two extra pickups per year of Garbage, Green Waste, or select Large items (e.g., furniture, mattresses, etc.) at no additional cost. **Note: offerings differ for residents in apartments and must be arranged through the property manager.** Additional Large/Bulky Items can be collected for a fee. 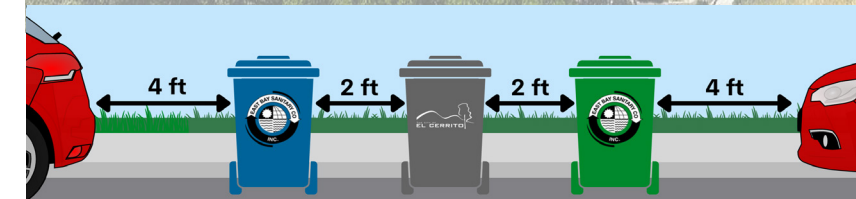

Cart Set Out & Curbside Information

- Garbage, recycling, and organic waste are collected every week. See El-Cerrito.org/rates and Ebsan.com for rates.
- Carts should be placed on the street with the wheels against the curb by 6am on your collection day.
- Carts must be removed from curb by midnight on collection day.
- Leave 2 feet between carts and place them 4 feet from cars, power poles, mail boxes, trees or other objects.
- Bungee cords must be removed by 6am on collection day.
- Do not overfill carts; lids should close and material should move freely within the cart. Overage fees may apply if over-flowing. Materials placed outside of the carts will not be picked up.
- Sort properly (see inside brochure). Recycling and organic carts containing garbage may be subject to contamination charges.
- Holiday Schedule: Curbside collection occurs on all holidays except Christmas Day and New Year's Day. If those holidays fall on a regular collection day, then collection for that day and all following days in that week will occur one day later than usual.

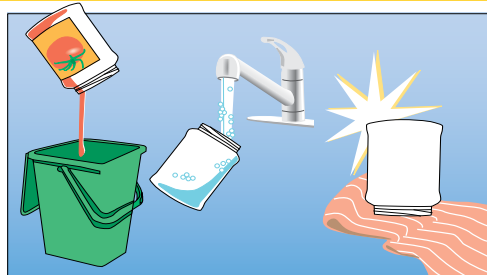

SERVICES



Senate Bill (SB) 1383 & Municipal Code 8.12

Requires that all residents must subscribe to the City's 3 cart system and properly sort recycling, organics, and garbage correctly. Ongoing failure to separate materials correctly may result in contamination charges. Visit Ebsan.com/recycling-laws/ for additional information.

Container Size:

To accommodate more recyclable material, and maximize diversion potential EBS and El Cerrito encourage the standard service of 20-gallon trash carts and 64-gallon recycling and organics carts. If more space is needed 35 and 64-gallon size trash carts are available, and carts for organics are available in both 35 and 64-gallon carts.

FREE Electronic and Universal Waste Pick-up

Curbside pickup of batteries, fluorescent lamps and electronics up to three times per year. Call East Bay Sanitary at 510-237-4321 for details and to schedule an appointment.

FREE Annual Bulk Recycling Pick-up

Residents get one bulky recycling pick-up per year. Call El Cerrito Recycling at 510-215-4350 for details.

FREE Used Motor Oil & Filter Recycling Pick-up

Call 510-215-4350 to schedule a pick up or request a free oil recycling kit.

FREE Christmas Tree Pick-up

Non-flocked, clean, natural Christmas trees are collected on your first two collection days in January. Place next to cart or cut up and place in green cart for collection day. Call East Bay Sanitary at 510-237-4321 for details.

Special Services

- **Backyard collection service for residents with mobility limitations—available at no extra cost. Call 510-237-4321 for eligibility details.**
- **Door-to-Door Household Hazardous Waste Collection for those 65 or older or disabled. By appointment only. Call 1-888-412-9277 for eligibility details.**
