### 51% of What California Homes Send to Landfill Could Be **Recycled or Composted**

Earlier this year, CalRecycle, the state agency that oversees waste management in California, conducted inspections in 16 different communities to get a better idea of what residents were placing in their garbage containers. Experts sifted through 60,000 lbs. of waste & found that 51% of what households sent to landfills could have been recycled or composted.

Residential homes landfilled an estimated 5 million tons of waste in 2024. 35% of that waste (1.7 million tons) was compostable - food scraps, yard waste & food-soiled paper - that could have become nutrient rich soil for farms, vineyards & gardens.

The U.N. Food & Agriculture Org. estimates that 1 lb. of food waste creates 4 lbs. of methane - a greenhouse gas that traps 80x more heat than carbon dioxide. Composting prevents methane emissions by allowing oxygen to flow during decompostion - unlike landfills that cut off oxygen as more waste is piled on. Placing our compostables in the green cart instead of the garbage makes a big difference in our fight against climate change. Every bit counts! Keep on composting!
