DEBRIS BOX INSTRUCTIONS

The rates for debris boxes for one week are as follows:

10 cubic yards - \$450.00 plus dump fees 20 cubic yards - \$450.00 plus dump fees 30 cubic yards - \$550.00 plus dump fees

Dump fees are not guaranteed. Current dump rates are as follows:

Garbage or C&D \$225.00/ per ton
Green Waste \$225.00/per ton
Dirt \$85.00/per ton
Clean Concrete/Asphalt Market Value
Certification of C&D Load \$60.00 per load

Dump fee charges will be passed on to the customer as they occur. No allowance will be made for added weight due to the rain. Customer assumes responsibility for any unauthorized third party use of debris boxes.

Rental price is based on 7-day rental. If customer wishes to keep the box longer, the customer must notify our office prior to regularly scheduled pick up date. There will be a **\$25.00** per day demurrage fee for any debris box kept longer than 7 days.

To schedule a delivery or pickup of a debris box, please call our office 48 hours in advance. If delivery or pickup of debris box is not completed as scheduled due to circumstances beyond East Bay Sanitary's control, a **\$150.00** rescheduling will be assessed.

Customer will be held liable for all repair costs arising from damage to debris box resulting from any attempt to move, push, shift, or lift the debris box from its original placement location.

When using a 20-yard debris box for dirt or concrete, fill to no more than one third (1/3) of capacity or approximately 7 yards. If this limit is exceeded the customer will be responsible for removing the material from the box before the box is removed. Debris box can be filled no higher than the sides. Doors of debris box must be properly closed and locked for final pickup.

If a certificate for a C&D load is needed,	please notify our office pr	rior to the scheduled pickup date	e. Additional fee will apply.

Certain materials are **NOT** accepted at the landfill and therefore may not be placed in the debris box. Unacceptable materials include those defined as hazardous or toxic by governmental regulations such as paints, solvents, pesticides, oil or other chemicals. In addition, tree stumps or root balls larger than 3x3x3 are not accepted. Pieces of concrete or asphalt or any other object larger than 3x3x3 are not accepted. Any material placed in the box that is unacceptable at the landfill will have to be removed or disposed of in a way that fulfills the legal requirements. In such a case this expense shall be the customer's responsibility.

Effective February 9, 2006 households and small businesses can no longer dispose of "universal" hazardous wastes into trash receptacles or debris boxes. Items include household batteries, compact fluorescent tubes, fluorescent bulbs and other mercury-containing lamps, mercury thermostats and the following electronic devices, TVs, computer monitors, CPUs and peripherals, radios and CD players, VCRs and DVD players, cell phones, cordless phones, telephone answering machines and microwaves. These devices have been tested by the Department of Toxic Substances Control and have failed California hazardous waste thresholds, often containing heavy metals like lead, cadmium, copper, and chromium.

In addition to paints, pesticides, motor oil etc. the West County Household Hazardous Waste Facility will now also accept the above listed "universal" hazardous wastes. Limit: 5 large electronic items per visit.

Residents in West Contra Costa County, including the Cities of El Cerrito, Hercules, Pinole, Richmond, San Pablo, El Sobrante, Kensington, Rodeo, and Crockett can deliver their hazardous waste to the West County Household Hazardous Waste Facility located at 101 Pittsburg Avenue, Richmond, open Thursdays, Fridays, and the first Saturday each month from 9am – 4pm (closed 12-12:30pm for lunch). Call 1-888-412-9277 or visit www.recyclemore.com for more information. There is no charge to residents for this service. Small businesses are charged a fee depending on waste.
